Sunday 20th September 2020, Rev Pete *Exile lessons 2: Jeremiah continued*

Did any of you take last week's challenge to read some of Jeremiah? Jean and I did! I am not very disciplined at sitting down with the Bible every day, but whenever I do, I learn so much! For example, I learnt that the phrase "backsliding" (v3:22) is not a modern term! And the phrase "a den of robbers" (v7:11) originates here, which Jesus quotes when he overturns tables in the temple courts (Matt 21:13, Luke 19:46). This week Pete challenged us with the question:

- **What is it I'm called to be and do?** If you're not sure, can I prompt you to read God's promise in Jeremiah 33 verse 3.
